

Download a Playlist to Hudl Video Editor

The purpose of this tutorial is to demonstrate the concept of downloading a playlist from Hudl.com to Hudl Video Editor.

In Hudl, all of your video is stored online. Once you have published video to Hudl.com, you can delete the projects from your computer so there is no need to purchase extra equipment to store your video footage. If you need to view game footage or an opponent scout where you know you will not get an internet connection, Hudl makes it easy to download your video from Hudl.com, back to Hudl Video Editor, making it possible to view your video without an internet connection.

Download a Playlist

Downloading a playlist allows you to copy a playlist with all of its associated data from Hudl.com to your computer. This could be useful if you want to watch film without an internet connection, for instance on a bus or plane.

- 1) Click **Download Project** to begin the download process. The **Login to Account** dialog will appear.
- 2) Enter your login information and click **Login**. Logging in ensures that you see the correct teams and playlists from Hudl.
- 3) Select a team from the **Pick Team** drop-down list.
- 4) Click **OK** to select the team.
- 5) Click the white expander arrows to expand the library tree and click on the playlist you want to download from your Hudl.com library.
- 6) The **Angles** box will list the different angles associated with the playlist. You must have at least one angle selected to download, so ensure the box is checked, even if there is only one angle.
- 7) The **Project Name** box will automatically populate in the format Year – School – Playlist name. If you would like to rename the project, change the name in the project name box.
- 8) The project will automatically download to your Video Editor Projects folder (which is most likely in your 'My Documents' or 'Documents' folder). Click the **Pick** button if you would like to change the location the project will be saved.



- 9) Click **Download** to begin downloading the project. The Download Progress dialog will appear. This dialog will provide you information about the download progress.
- 10) When the download is complete, click **OK** to continue. The project will automatically open for viewing in the Hudl Video Editor.
